On April 20, 2018, the Court issued Administrative Order 2018-03 to provide for the orderly administration of cases filed in Youngstown upon the retirement of Judge Kay Woods. The Court now issues this administrative order to supersede Administrative Order 2018-03 and to provide for the reassignment of cases to Judge Tiiara Patton.

- 1. Effective September 1, 2020, all Youngstown cases and related adversary proceedings shall be transferred to Judge Patton, except for the cases and proceedings listed in Attachment A.
- 2. All deadlines, hearing dates, and other requirements in pending cases and proceedings transferred to Judge Patton shall remain in effect, absent further order of the Court.
- 3. Effective August 17, 2020, all new, refiled, and reopened
 Youngstown cases and related adversary proceedings shall be assigned to Judge
 Patton even if the earlier case or proceeding had been assigned to a different Judge.

- 4. Nothing in this administrative order shall preclude the reassignment of cases, proceedings, or matters from one Judge to another Judge with the consent of both Judges.
- 5. Effective September 1, 2020, Administrative Order 2018-03 shall be deemed vacated by this administrative order.
